Scaffolding

Deliver content in increasingly complex learning "chunks" while removing those learning chunks, or scaffolding, as learner gains competency and progresses.

How do I use this in my classroom?

Provide learners with "think time" within the session.

Some ideas include:

- Fishbowl Activity,
- Think-pair-share,
- Turn and talk,
- Triad teams

When to use it?

When introducing a new concept.

Present information at a level just beyond what the learners currently understand.

Provide multiple formats and opportunities for learners to explore the information, generate connections, and practice retrieval meaningfully.

Why Use it?

Scaffolding is a framework that helps learners to advance in areas they cannot accomplish on their own. The instructor facilitates learning by guiding learners to enhance understanding, application, and synthesis.

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
