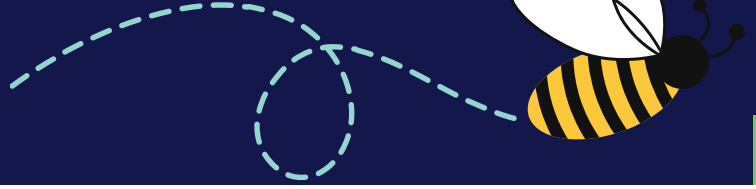

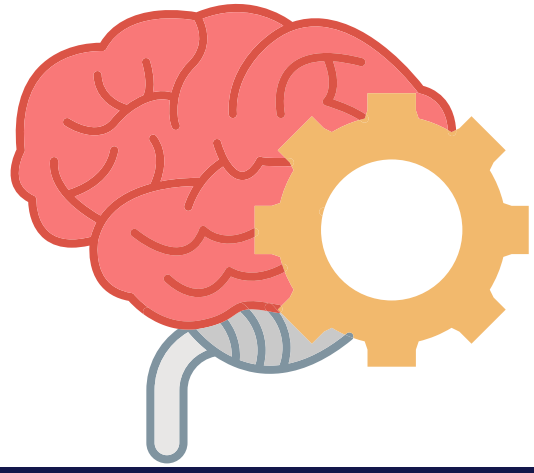
### SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT



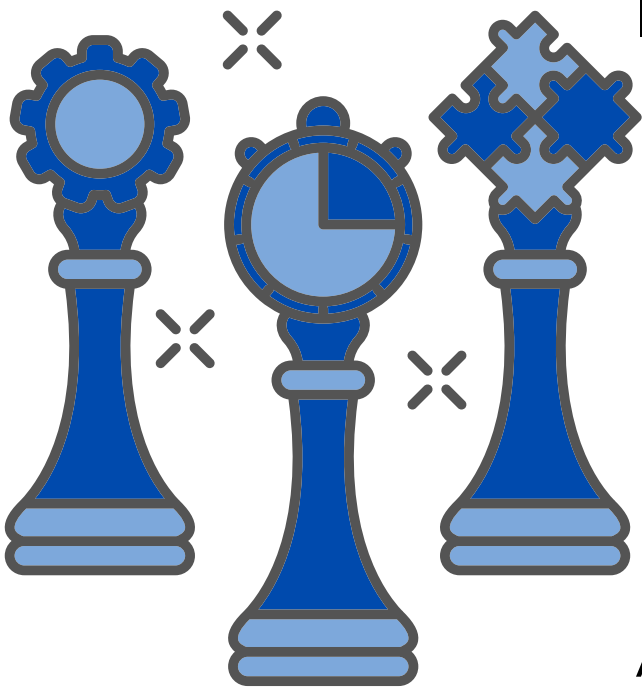
Final evaluation of learner progress. This is used to determine if learners achieved learning outcomes for a session, course, or program.

#### WHEN TO USE IT?

At the culmination of a unit of information.



#### HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?



Helpful summative feedback matches the information learned and outcomes desired.

- Written (e.g., English),
- oral (e.g., second language),
- performance (e.g., dance or theater), or
- standardized assessments (e.g., MCAT, GRE)

All are good options for various scenarios.

#### WHY USE IT?

Both learners and instructors can objectively see whether understanding of information and mastery of learning outcomes were achieved.
